Welcome

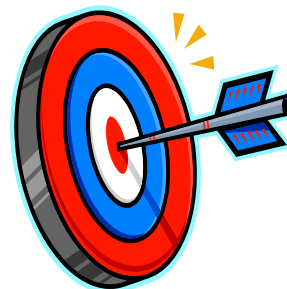
It's almost half term already! This half term has flown by and the children have been really busy learning and having fun. Have a good half term break and we will see you on Monday 6th June!
