It is lovely to see the children keen and ready to come to school first thing in the morning.

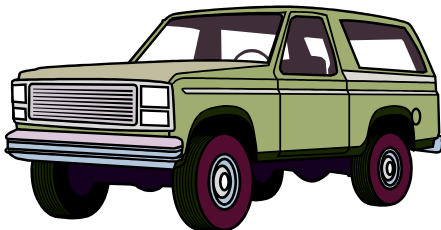
If you are waiting with your child, can you please stop them from climbing on the wooden outdoor classrooms and the fences in the front playground.
